DEOMORNOI DEGREE COLLEGE

A BRIEF INTRODUCTION

Deomornoi is a place of historical significance in the North Western part of Darrang district. It is located about 15 kms away towards the west of Mangaldai town. The need of an institution for higher education was felt during the early nineteen nineties by the residents of the area. Subsequently the Deomornoi Degree College was established in 1993 with the objective of imparting quality higher education to aspiring students. The college is situated near the famous Siala Vaishnab Temple on the bank of historically famous Mornoi River. The College campus comprises of 25 bighas of land with adequate infrastructural facilities. At present, it has around 1100 students with the staff strength of forty-six employees. The college is permanently affiliated to Gauhati University and received permission to offer major courses in almost all the subjects of the arts stream. It offers computer application as a vocational subject. The college also has a contact centre for M.A. course under IDOL, Gauhati University.

FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP)

The Gauhati University is going to implement the Four Years Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) from the academic session 2023-2024. The Programme is based on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The new undergraduate programme has been designed to cater to the diverse academic needs of the students. There will be options of multiple entries and exits, that is a student can exit from the programme at the end of first or second year and then again can enter the programme at a later time and can continue the programme from where he or she had left. If a student exits after the successful completion of first year, he/she will be awarded a Certificate, if a student exits after successful completion of second year he/she will be awarded a Diploma and if a student successfully completes three years of undergraduate study he will be awarded a Bachelor's Degree with or without major. Further, a student will be awarded Bachelor's Degree with Honours or a Bachelor's Degree with Honours and Research at the successful completion of four years of undergraduate course.

Curricular Components.

The entire FYUGP curriculum is divided into two parts – (1) Core Courses (2) Common Courses.

1. Core Courses:

The core courses constitute of Major and Minor courses. Generally, a student needs to choose one major subject and two minor subjects.

- (A) Major Course: The minimum credit requirements for a major course over a three-year period is 60 which is divided into 15 papers- Semester 1 (One paper), Semester 2 (One paper), Semester 3 (One paper), Semester 4 (Four papers), Semester 5 (Four papers) and Semester 6 (Four papers)
- (B) Minor Course: The minimum credit requirements for a minor course over a three years period is 12 which is divided into 3 papers. A student needs to opt for two minor subjects and study one paper each from both the subjects in the first semester, one paper each for both the subjects in second semester and also one paper each for both the subjects in the third semester.
- (C) Second Major Course: Provided a student has a Major course with 60 credit, he/she can convert one of his minor courses to a second major only with a credit allocation of 48. In that case, he or she gets a degree with Double Major and minor.


2. Common Courses :

As the name suggests, these courses will have to be studied by all students of FYUGP. Together the common Courses have a credit allocation of 36 divided over five sub divisions –

- (A) Value added courses (VAC): Total Credit 6 (Semester 1, two credits & semester 2, two credits & Semester 4, 2 credits).
- (B) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): Total Credit 8 (Semester 1, two credits & semester 2, two credits, semester 5, 2 credits & semester six, 2 credits).
- (C) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): Total credit 9 (Semester 1, three credits; semester 2, three credits; semester 3, three credits).
- (D) Multidisciplinary Course (MDC): Total credit 9; (Semester 1, three credits; Semester 2, three credits; Semester 3, three credits).
- (E) Internship: Total credit 4 (a student needs to do internship of four credits starting from semester third to sixth)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Discipline

Maintenance of strict discipline inside the college campus is compulsory.

- Use of mobile phones by the students inside the college campus is strictly prohibited. Smoking or using intoxicating drugs inside the college campus is strictly forbidden.
- Students found encouraging or participation in ragging of any kind, will be debarred from the college.
- Stringent action will be taken against those students who show misbehavior towards any other students, professors or employees of the college.
- Students will face penalty, if they destroy any college properties or involve in any kind of activities detrimental to the academic atmosphere of the college.

Attendance

- A Student will not be allowed to sit for Semester examinations as regular candidate if he/she does not attend a minimum of 80% lectures in each subject separately.
- A student who does not appear for the sessional examinations will not be permitted to appear for the semester examinations.

Co- curricular/Extra-curricular activities

Various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities like indoor and outdoor games, debate, seminar, cultural programmes, festivals etc. are organized in the college for all round development of the students. They are encouraged to get themselves involved with various co- curriculums and extra curricular activities in the college.

Facilities Available

Classrooms:

Sufficient number of classrooms are available in the college.

Library:

The college has a library with around 10,000 books, Magazines, Newspapers and Journals. There is also provision for separate reading rooms for students and professors.

Laboratories:

There are separate laboratory rooms for practical subjects which are well equipped.

Internet facilities:

The College is connected with internet facilities provided by BSNL sponsored by UGC.

Study Centre of GUCDOE:

The College has a study centre of Gauhati University Centre for Distance and Online Education (GUCDOE).

College Magazine:

The college publishes an annual magazine by the name of 'Deomornoi Degree College Magazine'. It also publishes wall-magazines on special occasions like College Week, Saraswati Puja, Fateha-e-Dowaz Daham and Freshmen social. The Sahitya Parishad of the college also publishes a Journal of Poetry every year.

National Service Scheme (N.S.S):

There is a centre of the N.S.S. in Deomornoi Degree college. A number of programmes and educational excursions are organized by the unit and many of our volunteers have participated in many states and national level camps. The intending students may join the N.S.S. which gives an opportunity to develop their personalities and shape their attitude towards life. Sports Facilities:

The college has "Sports and Extra Curricular Cell" under IQAC which fosters a range of sports and games facilities to promote physical health and wellness among students.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Deomornoi Degree College was formed on 09/09/2021. It is the backbone of our college and it performs as a nodal agency of the institution to enhance the overall quality of the college. The main objective of the IQAC is to improve the academic and administrative excellence.

Grievance Redressal Cell:

The college has a grievance redressal cell to look into the grievances of the students, guardians, teachers and employees of the college. The cell takes appropriate steps for redressal of the genuine grievances and complaints in accordance with the guidelines for this purpose.

Students' Union:

Deomornoi Degree College Students' Union is the only recognized students' union of the college. Its membership is compulsory for every students' of the college. The students' union of the college has its own constitution according to which election is held annually and the executive bodies constituted for the term.

4. Eligibility for free admission/ Fee Waiver Scheme:

1. Students whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 2.00 Lakhs from all source will be eligible to avail this scheme.
2. If either of the parents (mother or father) of the student is working in the state Govt./Central Govt./ Semi Govt./ State or Central Govt. Undertakings, such students shall not be eligible under this scheme.
3. Students who belong to below poverty line and want to avail free Admission in B.A. First, 3rd & 5th Semester must have to plant a sapling in a public place. They have to

furnish copy of their own colour photo (size 4x5 inches) with the particular growing plants continuously for three years (B.A, 1st, 3rd and 5th Semester). Failing to do so, they will not be entitled for free admission in future. Fee waiver scheme is only for regular students having minimum 75% of attendance in classes with no back paper in previous examinations.

5. Proof of income/ Document Required:

- i) An Income certificate from the Local Revenue Circle Officer Only..
- ii) A declaration from the student that neither of the parent (father or mother) of the student is an employee of State/ Central Govt. Department or its undertakings, such form shall be devised by the concerned Resisters/ Principal. If such a declaration is found to be false, the admission shall be cancelled and fee shall be realized from such students.

6. Duties and Responsibilities of Students availing the Scheme:

Student seeking admission into 1st year needs to plant a sapling at his/ her College or at his/her home and should submit the photograph of the same to the college. The student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission in to second year should submit the photograph of the same tree that was planted during previous year.

Student availing the second-year fee waiver benefit during the current year should also plant a sapling and will nourish it and submit photograph of the same while availing fee waiver benefit subsequently.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application for admission to the college is to be made online through SAMARTH e-Govt Portal which is a common platform of Assam State Higher Education Department. The students who are willing to take admission in our college are instructed to visit the college website and click on the online admission icon which will automatically direct them to the SMARTH e- govt portal. Accordingly, they need to register in the portal and fill up the online admission forms after which they are required to submit the hardcopies of the form to the college office. A total of three merit list will be released on the portal and the students are requested to visit the portal regularly for updates.

Candidates selected for admission must bring with them the following original documents as well as photo copies at the time of admission:

- a. Pass Certificate, Registration Card and Mark sheets of both HSLC and HS examinations.
- b. Two copies of recent passport size photographs.
- c. Certificate for proof of age (HSLC Admit Card/Certificate)
- d. A Photo copy of Aadhar Card.
- e. ST/SC/OBC/MOBC Certificate
- f. Gap Certificate, wherever necessary, will have to be produced. It has to be issued by a gazette officer/head of the institution (Govt. recognized) last attended.
- g. True Copy of Students Bank Account No., IFS Code, Mobile No. & WhatsApp No. must be submitted

COLLEGE UNIFORM: College uniform is compulsory for all students.

- a. Uniform for Boys: Pant- Black, Shirt- Light Pink.
- b. Uniform for Girls: Trouser- White, Churidar- Light Pink, Churni-White.

IDENTITY CARD: The college Identity card is issued to every student at the time of admission. The Identity Card will remain valid for a period of one academic year. The Identity Card needs to be renewed by the concerned authority every year. In case of any loss or damage of the card, the matter should be immediately informed to the Principal and a duplicate Identity Card will be issued only after proper verification and on payment of the prescribe fee.

SCHOLARSHIPS: The students of Deomornoi Degree College are entitled to apply for the following scholarships as per rules:
